Dr. Isaac Berzin was named one of the 100 most influential people in politics, business, and science in 2008 by the Time magazine for his work in algal biofuels. He Dr. Isaac Berzin is a Senior Fellow at the Interdisciplinary Center in Herzliya, Israel (IDC) and the Founding Director of the Institute for Renewable Energy Policy (IREP). In addition, Dr. Berzin is an Affiliated Scientist at MIT, where he worked on a NASA-sponsored project, developing bioreactors for the International Space Station.



During 2001-2008 Isaac Berzin was the Chief Technology Officer of GreenFuel Technologies Corporation in Cambridge US. His innovative work in Cleantech has won numerous awards including the Frost and Sullivan Award (2006), Platts Global Energy Award (2006) and American Society of Competitiveness (ASC) Awards 2005, 2006, 2007. Isaac holds a PhD in Chemical Engineering and Biotechnology from Ben-Gurion University of the Negev, Israel.
