**Murray Weidenbaum** was President Reagan’s first chairman of the Council of Economic Advisers. He helped to formulate the economic policy of the Reagan Administration and was a key spokesman for the administration on economic and financial issues. He was the first Assistant Secretary of the Treasury for Economic Policy in the Nixon administration. He also served as Fiscal Economist in the U.S. Bureau of the Budget and as the Corporate Economist at Boeing Company.

He is known for his research on economic policy, taxes, government spending, and regulation.

The lecture will cover new laws and policies that shift power from the private sector to the public sector: tax policy changes, financial policy changes, and aid to the automobile companies. The effects of earlier experiences in business-government relations also will be covered.
